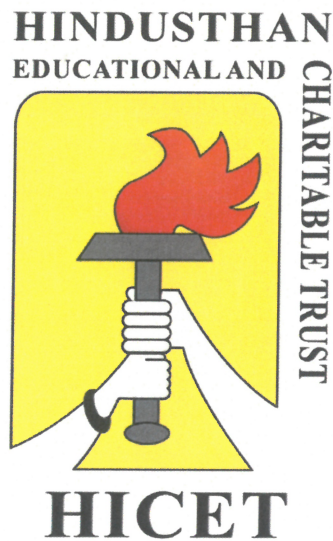


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CLUBS AND COMMITTEES POLICY

The club / committee policy of the institution shall be implemented with the support and active involvement of Management, Principal, faculty members and students of the institution to achieve excellence.

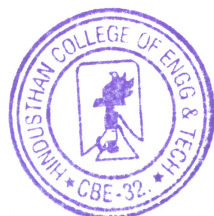
