

State Government Scholarships

There are several scholarships available under **State Government Scholarship** which are given below

| S.no | Scheme | Eligibility Condition |
|------|--|--|
| 1 | Scholarship to Son and Daughter of Differently Abled Persons, Tamil Nadu | The wards of any differently-abled person holding the Identity card issued by the Welfare Board of Differently Abled can apply for this scholarship. This scholarship is available for the student who is studying in class XI to postgraduate level |
| 2 | Deceased Government Servants Scholarship, Tamil Nadu | The scholarship is applicable for the wards of deceased government servants who died in harness |
| 3 | Free Education Schemes for BC, MBC & DNC students, Tamil Nadu | The scholarship is open to students belonging to BC/MBC/DNC category who are pursuing a 3-year degree or polytechnic diploma course or professional degree course. The annual income of the family should not exceed more than Rs. 50,000. |
| 4 | PERARIGNAR Anna Memorial Award, Tamil Nadu | The top two boys and two girls of each district in Tamil Nadu who have scored the highest marks in class 12th and are pursuing a Professional degree course (medical, engineering, law, etc.) can apply for this scholarship. The scheme is available only for BC/MBC/DNC students |
| 5 | VIDYADHAN Scholarship Program | Besides Tamil Nadu, the scholarship is also available for the residents of Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Kerala, and Telangana. The applicant must have passed out class 10th / SSLC from the above-mentioned states. The annual income of the family should not exceed more than Rs. 2 Lakh. |
| 6 | Chief Minister Farmers Security Scheme | Wards of Farmers |
| 7 | Tamil Nadu National Teacher Welfare Fund | Wards of Teachers |
| 8 | Tamil Nadu Educational Trust, Chennai | 60% and above Marks in HSC Parent annual Income should be less than 50,000/- |
| 9 | First Graduate Students | Applicant must belong to a family where no member is a graduate. |
