Scope

The Scope of collaboration on academic and research activities in this Memorandum of Understanding includes the following categories:

1. Academic and Research collaboration in the areas of mutual interest.
2. Exchange of academic information, scholarly information, materials and publications.
3. Exchange of students and faculty.
4. Sponsorship of cooperative seminars, workshops and other academic meetings on latest technology advancements
5. Twinning and Joint Programmes

Student Exchange

Pursuant to the agreement for academic exchange, Dambi Dollo University, Ministry of Education, Ethiopia and Hindusthan Educational Institutions, Coimbatore, India will exchange students according to the terms laid out in Annexure 1. It is desired by both parties that there will be significant flow of students in both directions.

Research Collaboration

Faculty from both Institutions will collaborate in the supervision of exchange students and in joint research in disciplines of mutual interest. All such joint research activities will be governed by the terms laid out in Annexure 2.



Criterion II
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Commencement, renewal, termination and amendment

This MOU will come into force upon affixing of the signatures of the representatives of the partner institutions and will remain in effect for five years. This MOU may be renewed upon its expiry, with the agreement of both partner institutions.

If either partner institution wishes to terminate the MOU at the end of the five years period it must notify the other institution not less than six months prior to the expiry of the MOU.

This MOU or its renewal and the actions taken under it may be reviewed at any time. Modifications may be made by mutual agreement and any amendment or extension to the agreement may be formalized by the exchange of letters between the two parties.

Annexure 1

1. Students under the student exchange programme will be classified as special exchange students. Special exchange students will be permitted to take courses on credit / audit, as well as participate in research activities / project work.
2. In any case, the consent of the teacher / project supervisors / research supervisors is required. Such consent will take into account among other things whether the student has pre-requisites for the course / project.
3. The Host Institution of students enrolled in this exchange program shall not levy tuition fees. Home Institution may continue to levy fees as applicable.
4. Course credits and grades earned will be determined by the home institution based on the grade report from the host institution.
5. Each institution will accept up to 50 students each year.
6. Participants may not spend more than one year normally in the exchange programme.
7. Participants will be subjected to the rules and regulations of the host institution, in addition to specific rules and regulations, if any, of the host country regarding foreign students studying in the host country.
8. Joint Supervisor in Ethiopia will be approved by Hindusthan Educational Institutions for those candidates with good Publication records.

Selection and Nomination

The selection and nomination of students is open throughout the academic year. The student nomination should be accompanied by:

- Curriculum vitae.
- Statement of aptitude from a member of the student's school / faculty.
- A specific outline of the programme of study at the host institution and a statement of objectives of the student.

When a nomination is forwarded by the home institution, it is presumed that the sending institution considers the student suitable for the proposed program and consents to send the student if selected by the host institution.

The host institution will evaluate the nomination and determine their suitability for selection under the Student Exchange Program.

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Teaching-Learning and Evaluation

Where the exchange student is pursuing a research or implementation project as part of the B.E., B.Tech, M.E., M.Tech, B.A., B.Sc., BBA, BCom, M.A., M.Sc., MCom, MCA, MBA, or PhD (or equivalent) degree programme, the host institution will provide a suitable faculty member to jointly assist (along with the supervisor in the parent institution) the exchange student in formulating research project or jointly supervising the exchange student in the event that a research project has already been identified.

The host institution will inform the home institution of any academic or other problems that may arise during the period of student's residence in the host institution. The host institution will take appropriate action under its established policy and procedures, in consultation with the home institution to deal with such problems.

Annexure 2

- Proposals for collaborative research work under this Memorandum will be submitted with the prior approval of the Head of each institution, or his / her nominee.
- Each institution will nominate one of its members as its representative in charge of the cooperative program. Individual programs of work under this Memorandum will be jointly planned and conducted by the nominees of both parties.
- Progress of work of any individual program will be reviewed and approved by designated authorities of both parties.
- The final approval of any project will depend on the availability of guaranteed support funds.
- Neither Dambi Dollo University, Ministry of Education, Ethiopia nor Hindusthan Educational Institutions, Coimbatore, India will be held responsible for any liability to the other party, and neither party shall be required to purchase any insurance against loss or damage to any property due to activities to which this agreement relates.

Every collaboration will have its own agreement / contract which addresses issues such as IPR, funding pattern, disclosure of information etc.

Memorandum of Understanding

AND

The Rubber, Chemical & Petrochemical Skill Development Council (RCPSDC), a Not for profit company under Section 25 of the Companies Act 1956, under the aegis of National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) whose office is at 304, 03rd Floor, Rectangle One, District Centre Saket, New Delhi - 110017 (herein after referred to as "RCPSDC", which expression shall unless it is repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to mean and include its successors in interest and permitted assigns.) on the SECOND PARTY.

1) Objectives of the MoU

HiCET would be taking preliminary steps for introducing and implementing rubber courses/programmes aligned to National Occupational Standards (NOS) developed by RCPSSDC, mutually decided by both the parties, which would aim to enhance the employability of students of HiCET by equipping them with Industry / sector relevant skills.

And, RCPSSDC through its Education & Skill Development initiatives will work closely with its members and Industry Associations to help improve the quality of the employable skills of the students of HiCET. The students will be assessed as per RCPSSDC set standards and guidelines.

Now it is hereby mutually agreed amongst both parties to this MoU and binds themselves to the terms and conditions enumerated in succeeding paragraphs:

2) Responsibility and deliverables of HiCET

- a) To appoint and empowered committee of HiCET to align the courses in accordance to National Occupational Standards (NOS) developed by RCPSSDC and suggest suitable changes.
- b) To select relevant job role for the students and take RCPSSDC approval for implementation.
- c) To arrange infrastructure at existing Institute premises to carry out training batches, thus enabling to utilize the existing infrastructure and other facilities present in their premises.
- d) To do promotional activities so as to publicize the initiative for skill development and to facilitate mobilization of trainees.
- e) To mobilize the trainees/students.
- f) Execute program as per content designed and developed by RCPSSDC.
- g) Plan and schedule training batches.
- h) Ensure monitoring of the courses and obtain feedback for the utility of the courses being offered.
- i) Developing tools and rubrics for quality assurance.
- j) Conduct review sessions for feedback w.r.t.:
 - i. The quality of sessions;
 - ii. Alterations to program design;
- k) Help finalize all the logistics for the assessment Test and Examination of the students.

3) Responsibility and deliverables of RCPSSDC

- a) To assist HiCET by providing curriculum and content for the courses aligned with the rubber sector National Occupational Standards (NOS).
- b) To facilitate training of trainers and help in provisioning of Master Trainers from the industry, on as required basis.

- c) Support in connecting with industry to enable the students to have practical training and skill development on the job.
- d) To ensure quality of training delivery by adopting a stringent accreditation process for training service providers, assessments and certification of trainees.
- e) Conduct quality audit on the delivery and other operational activities undertaken by HiCET with regard to rubber courses.
- f) To conduct assessment of students through RCPSDC appointed assessment agency.
- g) Issue certification by HiCET, RCPSDC, NSDC & GOI to those students who have cleared / passed the assessment exam / test conducted by RCPSDC appointed assessment agency through Skill India Portal.
- h) Organize industry for students in consultation with HiCET to get practical and industry exposure.
- i) To arrange assured placement for the certified students in consultation with HiCET.

4) Financials:

HiCET shall pay RCPSDC one-time affiliation fee as per RCPSDC affiliation protocol schedule I as mentioned below:

6. EFFECTIVE DATE, DURATION AND TERMINATION
