Batch 2019

- I. Humanities and Social Sciences (HS) courses include Technical English, Professional English, Basic German, Basic French, Employability Skills, Engineering Ethics and Human Values, Life Skills, Communication skills, Engineering Economics and Management – Total 11 Credits
- II. Basic Sciences (BS) courses include Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, etc – Total 28 Credits
- III. Engineering Sciences (ES) courses include Engineering Practices, Engineering Graphics, Basics of Electrical/Electronics/Civil/Mechanical/Computer Engineering, etc – Total 14 Credits
- IV. Professional Core (PC) courses include the core courses relevant to the chosen specialization / branch – Total 76 Credits
- V. Professional Elective (PE) courses include the elective courses relevant to the chosen specialization / branch and offered by the respective department – Total 15 Credits
- VI. Open Elective (OE) Courses offered by a discipline for students other than the corresponding discipline students – Total 6 Credits
- VII. Employability Enhancement Courses (EEC) includes Project Work, Internship, Seminar, Professional Practices, Case Study and Industrial training / Practical Training – Total 15 Credits
- VIII. Audit Courses(AC) expose the students to Unnat Bharathi Abhiyan, Constitution of India, Essence of Indian Knowledge Traditional, Yoga, English for Research Paper Writing, Value Education, Pedagogy Studies, Stress Management and Personality Development through Life

Enlightenment Skills. Registration to Minimum of one course is mandatory to Students in Semester I to IV.

4. As Per the suggestion from the chairman the following meeting are scheduled Department Advisory Committee meeting in the Second week of March, Board of studies meeting in the month of April.
