1	Government Scholarship for OBC	[Government Quota] BC, BCM, MBC, DNC Parent Annual Income should be less than 2,00,000/-
2	Government Scholarship for SC & ST	[Government Quota & Management Quota] SC, SCA, ST Parent Annual Income should be less than 2,50,000/- [Government Quota & Management Quota] SCC* [*SC Caste Converts Christianity] Parent Annual Income should be less than 2,00,000/-
3	Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College Students and University Students	955/1200 and above Marks in HSC Parent Annual Income should be less than 6,00,000/-
4	Merit Scholarship for Government School Students	Highest Marks in HSC & Studied in Municipal / Corporation School
5	AICET pragati scholarship for girls	Be admitted to the first year of diploma/degree level course OR Be admitted to the second year of diploma/degree level course through lateral entry in any of the AICTE-approved institutions of the respective year Have a family income of less than INR 8 lakh per annum
6	National Level Talent Search Exam	National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT)
7	Post Matric Scholarship For Students With Disabilities	Be studying from Class 11 to post graduation from any university recognized by UGC/AICTE Have more than 40% disability certified by the competent authority Have an annual family income of less than INR 2.50 lakh
8	Post matric scholarship scheme for minorities	Have secured at least 50% marks or equivalent grades in the previous final examination. Have an annual family income of less than INR 2.5 lakh from all the sources

9	Merits cum means scholarship for professional and t	Have secured at least 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination. Have an annual family income of less than INR 2.50 lakhs from all sources
10	Prime Minister scholarship scheme	Have secured a minimum of 60% marks in Minimum Entry Qualification (MEQ) i.e. Class 12/Diploma/Graduation or equivalent (for new applicant) Have passed each subsequent academic year of the professional courses with a minimum of 50% marks (for renewal)
11	Minority Scholarship	Christians, Muslims, Sikhs & Buddhist 50% marks in previous exam
