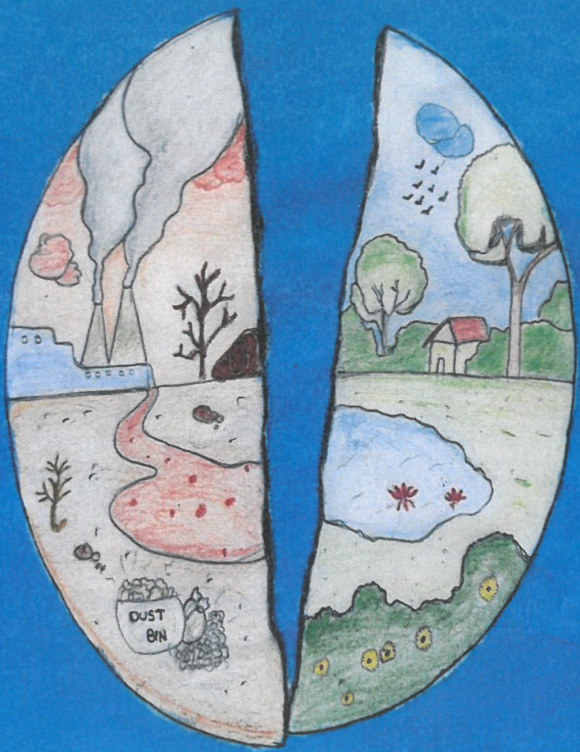
WASTE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM BROKEN
