### Activities

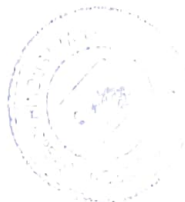
1. Organizing different activities to make the girl students, faculty members and staffs is aware of their health, sports, self-defense etc.
