

The department has various clubs namely Finance Club, Marketing Club, Human Resource Club, Entrepreneurship Development Club, Business Analytics and Debate Club.


The details of programmes organised by the department are as follows:












Geographical Diversity of Students during AY 2021- 2022




Gender Diversity of Students during AY 2021- 2022
