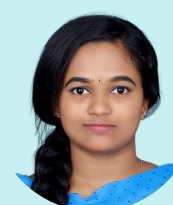

1. MBA Inauguration - 2020

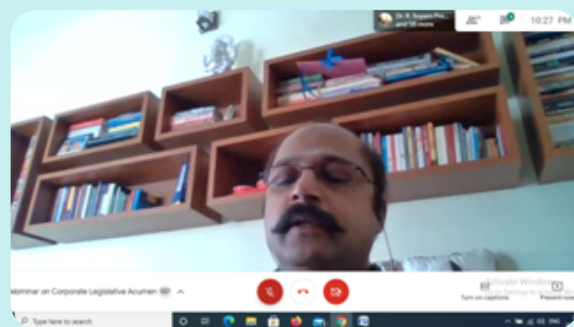

2. MBA Orientation Programme - 2020

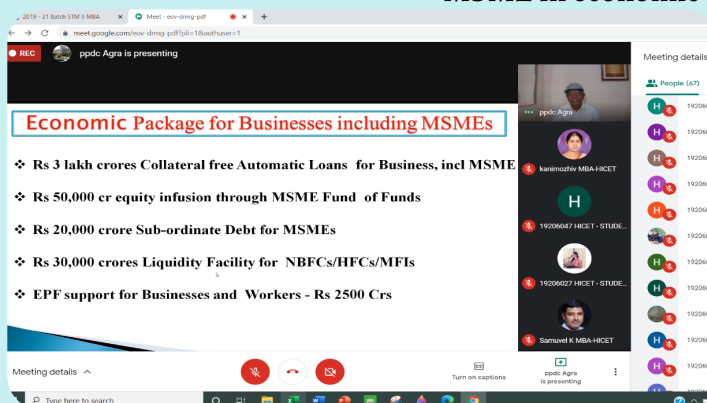

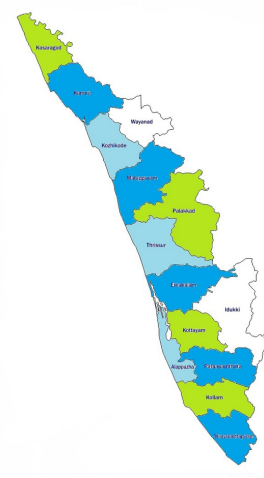


Geographical Diversity of Students in AY 2020- 2021

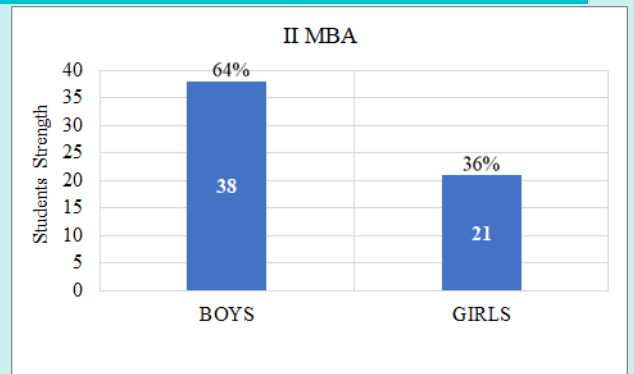
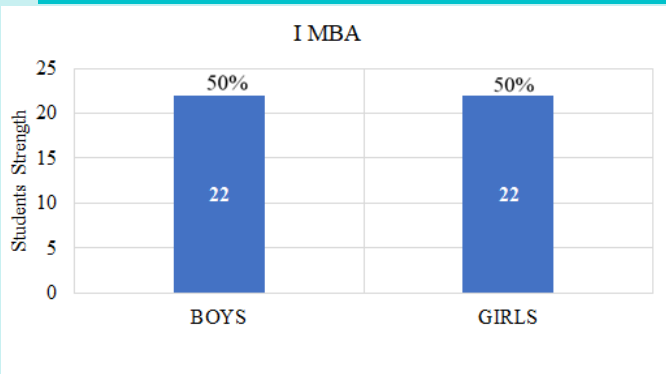

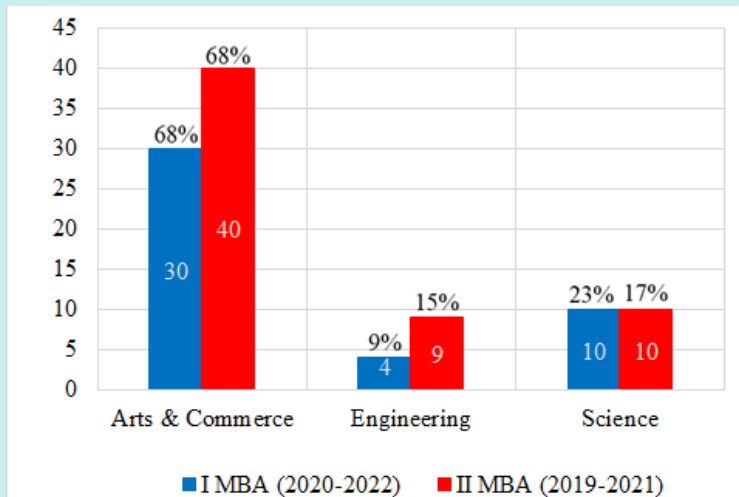
