The 19th IQAC meeting was conducted on 05.05.2025, 10.30 a.m. at the IQAC Board room, Hindusthan College of Engineering and Technology, Coimbatore.

1. Dr.J.Jaya, Chairman, IQAC and Principal welcomed all the members for the meeting.
2. The action taken report of the previous meeting was reported by the IQAC Coordinator and it was confirmed.
3. Principal happily announced that the following five UG Programmes
 - B.E Computer Science and Engineering- validity upto 30.06.2027
 - B.Tech Information Technology- validity upto 30.06.2027
 - B.E Electronics and Communication Engineering- validity upto 30.06.2027
 - B.E Electrical and Electronics Engineering- validity upto 30.06.2027
 - B.E Mechanical Engineering- validity upto 30.06.2027

has been accredited by National Board of Accreditation (NBA) under Tier- I category. It was informed that B.Tech Chemical Engineering programme is under process for NBA accreditation, and the expert team visit is expected in couple of months.

The Chairman informed that so far 12 UG and 2 PG programmes are NBA accredited, and the Management Representative appreciated the efforts taken by the Principal and all staff members in achieving this accreditation status.

4. Principal informed that annual submission of AQAR for academic year 2023-24 was submitted before the stipulated date and the same was accepted by NAAC on 21.01.2025.
5. The National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) - Government of India, Ministry of Education's Flagship Scheme NIRF 2025 data was submitted by our institution during January 2025. This time our institution has applied under the following categories
 - i.Engineering
 - ii.Innovation
 - iii.Overall
 - iv.Research
 - v.SDGs

and our institution looks forward to secure a good position in NIRF 2025.

6. The Chairperson proudly announced that our institution is ranked among the top 200 in the country as per the NPTEL Local Chapter Rating, with 1,288 certifications including 11 national toppers, 7 Elite with Gold, 135 Elite with Silver, and 529 Elite certifications and the institution was honoured with the 'Valuable Local Chapter' award and an 'A' rating in recognition of this achievement.
7. It was put forth that the extension of research centre recognition to pursue PhDs from Anna University, Chennai is received for the following departments
 - i.Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering validity upto December 2027
 - ii.Department of Computer Science and Engineering validity upto December 2027Principal requested all heads of research centres to enhance their research output to facilitate an easy renewal process.



8. The end semester results for UG/PG programmes for the academic year 2024-25 (Odd Sem) was discussed and the management representative appreciated the efforts taken by oCoE.
9. Principal proudly announced that our institution has successfully implemented various 17 AICTE Schemes in campus. Further emphasized that recently our Institution implemented AICTE schemes like AICTE- VAANI (Vibrant Advocacy for Advancement and Nurturing of Indian Languages), AICTE- DPS (Distinguished Professionals Scheme), AICTE- SCCN (Smart Campus Cloud Network), AICTE- CEEE (Centre for Engineering Education Excellence) and AICTE- QIP (Quality Improvement Programme). It was added that only few institutions incorporated many AICTE schemes and the Management Representative appreciated the Principal and all staff members for the successful implementation of the same.
10. National Board of Accreditation (NBA) new manual been published during July 2024 for Tier-I institutions. In this New Manual UN-SDGs are being implemented and fetch over 60 marks hence it is necessary to incorporate it in the Teaching Learning Process. In view of this, our institution is incorporating this SDG mapping with various events and in our curriculum by means of event reports and Course Information Sheet (CIS) respectively. The Management nominee appreciated the new initiatives taken by our Principal and all IQAC members unanimously appreciated the same.
11. It was noted that our institution is awarded with Titanium Band category in the Sustainable Institutions of India Green ranking 2025 in pursuit of excellence towards practising sustainable education. All IQAC members unanimously appreciated the efforts.
12. The SDGs Mapping Levels 0,1,2,3 are to be presented in the forthcoming Academic Council Meeting for Approval.
13. The Strategic Planning and Monitoring committee report for the completed Academic Year 2024-25 was discussed.
14. Ms.S.Hariniya, Student Representative shared the feedback on the activities of Student Quality Assurance Cell.
15. The Chairman and Chairpersons of various programmes conducted Board of Studies for the Academic Year: 2025- 26 (Odd Semester) courses and it was informed that 16th Academic Council Meeting to be conducted in accordance with the norms of the statutory bodies.
16. It was informed that as per research promotion policy of our institution, research incentives was disbursed in tune of Rs.1,89,900 for the categories like research paper publication, book publication, patent publication, funded R&D projects from the government and organising funded seminar, conference, workshops and STTPs.



17. IQAC coordinator proudly informed that under the Government of Tamil Nadu's Naan Mudhalvan Scheme (Niral Thiruvizha), 18 student projects have been awarded a total grant of ₹1,80,000 fostering innovation and entrepreneurship among young minds.
18. IQAC Coordinator announced that Third Edition of IEEE sponsored International Conference on Sustainable Computing and Smart Systems (ICSCSS 2025) is to be conducted in our campus during 20th to 22nd August with the support of Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE) and IEEE Systems Council.
19. IQAC members unanimously appreciated the Mechatronics Engineering student team, MV Tronics, for winning the Overall Championship at the SIEP E-Bike Challenge 2025, organized by the Imperial Society of Innovative Engineers (ISIE) at Galgotias University, Noida.
20. IQAC members appreciated the two teams of Aeronautical Engineering students won First Prize in IDEATHON 2025, organized by the National Institute of Ocean Technology (NIOT) and the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Madras.
21. Finally, the chairperson thanked all the members for their active participation and the meeting came to an end after a vote of thanks by the IQAC Coordinator at 12.15 pm.
